## Purpose of this Financial Services Guide

This *Financial Services Guide – Personal Advice* (FSG) provides you with important information about the advice services we offer to help you decide whether to use them.

- any fees, charges, remuneration or benefits that may be paid to Cbus
- our employees, representatives, related bodies and associates in relation to the services described in this FSG

- how your personal information is managed
- how we handle complaints about our services.

### Not independent

Our advisers are not independent, impartial or unbiased as they provide personal advice on Cbus Super and Media Super products only. Our advisers are employed and paid by the Trustee (who is also the product issuer).

### Product information

If you receive advice about obtaining a Cbus Super or Media Super product, you should read the relevant product disclosure statement (PDS) before making any decisions to acquire it. The PDS provides details of the terms and conditions of our products and will usually be provided before you join and when we recommend a product to you. 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## Before you get our advice

### Who provides financial services and products to me?

United Super Pty Ltd is the provider, through its representatives, of the financial services set out below. We hold an Australian Financial Services Licence (AFSL) under the *Corporations Act 2001*, and are responsible for services provided by our representatives.

### What financial services are available to me?

We provide the following financial services:

- General financial advice and personal financial advice that is strategic or non-product specific to members and their spouse/partner (where eligible) and personal financial advice to members about Cbus Super and Media Super superannuation products.
- General financial advice about life insurance and income protection products issued under a group policy with our insurer, TAL Life Ltd ABN 70 050 109 450 AFSL 237848.
- Superannuation trustee services, including issuing financial products in respect of Cbus Super and Media Super.

The different types of information and advice are explained below:

- **Factual information** is objectively obtainable information.
- **General financial advice** refers to information in relation to general features of the products and services but does not consider your personal circumstances, financial situation or objectives.
- **Personal financial advice** takes into account your personal circumstances, financial situation or objectives.

When contacting us, the type of advice or information provided will depend upon your needs, the services you access and the authority of the staff member you deal with in the areas outlined on the next page. In all circumstances, the person you deal with will let you know if the advice provided has taken into account your personal circumstances.

If you decide to act on the advice you've received, you may be required to instruct your super fund to make changes to your account. For certain transactions, you'll be able to make these changes through your online account or over the phone.

## Our Advice Services

### Our Advice team

We have a range of experienced advisers, supported by other specialists, servicing our members across Australia. Our financial advisers are authorised to provide general advice on a wide range of topics and personal advice on the following topics, Cbus Super and Media Super products, and for the member and their spouse/partner (where eligible):

<b>Superannuation Advisers</b>	Superannuation Advisers are authorised to provide <b>Advice Essentials</b> , which is personal financial advice in relation to Cbus Super and Media Super products, such as investment choice. This service is facilitated over the phone for members nationwide.
<b>Retirement Advisers</b>	Retirement Advisers are authorised to provide either Advice Essentials or <b>Advice Essentials Plus</b> , which is personal advice in relation to Cbus Super and Media Super products for members with retirement planning advice needs. Where the member's spouse/partner is not a member of Cbus Super or Media Super, the Retirement Adviser can provide strategic personal advice that takes into account their personal needs and circumstances.
<b>External Advisers</b>	Where you require financial advice beyond the scope of Advice Essentials or Advice Essentials Plus, we will refer you to an external accredited financial adviser who meets strict professional qualifications and service criteria, as set by us and the Financial Advice Association of Australia (FAAA).

### How you can pay for your advice fees

Where advice fees are payable, you will have various payment method options, including EFT (bank transfer) and credit card.

Where you receive advice from an external adviser, they can offer you advice on a fee-for-service basis under their own Australian Financial Services Licence.

### Statement of Advice

When we provide you with personal advice, our recommendations will be presented to you in a tailored financial plan, called a Statement of Advice (SOA).

A Statement of Advice is a document that provides information on the advice given to you. This includes:

- the basis for advice
- information about any fees or commissions that apply
- how to implement the advice.

You can request a copy of your SOA (within seven years from the date the advice was provided to you) by contacting the Advice team.

### What commissions or fees do staff receive?

Our advisers are salaried employees who don't receive any extra remuneration, commissions or bonus payments for the advice they provide to you.

Similarly, no fees are payable to or by Cbus for referrals to external advisers or the Financial Advice Association of Australia (FAAA).

Details of the fees charged for Cbus Super and Media Super products can be found in the relevant PDSs.
