1. Before you get our advice

Who provides financial services and products to me?

United Super Pty Ltd is the provider, through its representatives, of the financial services set out below.

We hold an Australian Financial Services Licence (AFSL) under the *Corporations Act 2001*, and are responsible for services provided by our representatives.

What financial services are available to me?

We provide the following financial services:

- General financial advice about Cbus Super and Media Super superannuation products.
- General financial advice about life insurance and income protection products issued under a group policy with our insurer, TAL Life Ltd ABN 70 050 109 450 AFSL 237848.
- Superannuation trustee services, including issuing financial products in respect of Cbus Super and Media Super.

The different types of information and advice are explained below:

- Factual information is objectively obtainable information.
- General financial advice refers to information in relation to general features of the products and services but does not consider your personal circumstances, financial situation or objectives.
- Personal financial advice takes into account your personal circumstances, financial situation or objectives. Refer to the *Financial Services Guide: Personal Advice* for more details of the personal financial advice services we offer.

If you need comprehensive financial advice about additional financial matters, our Advice team can refer members to an external accredited financial adviser who meets strict professional qualifications and service criteria, as set by us and the Financial Advice Association of Australia (FAAA).

An external financial adviser can offer comprehensive advice on a fee-for-service basis under their own Australian Financial Services Licence and any fees for advice will be agreed with you in advance. Eligible members can have fees for personal financial advice services deducted from their account.

Fee and costs

You can access and receive general advice services in relation to your Cbus Super or Media Super account as part of the administration fee you pay from your member account.

There are options for personal advice available from us. Refer to the *Financial Services Guide: Personal Advice* for more details, including any fees payable (where applicable).

Details of the fees charged for Cbus Super and Media Super products can be found in the relevant product disclosure statement.

Our general advice representatives are salaried employees who don't receive any extra remuneration for the advice they provide.

Cbus Property Pty Ltd ABN 48 115 826 741 is a wholly-owned entity of United Super Pty Ltd and is responsible for the development and management of our direct property investments.

We provide access to the QuickSuper clearing house facility to collect and distribute superannuation payments for employers (Westpac Banking Corporation ABN 33 007 457 141 AFSL 233714).

For Media Super (and former EISS employers) we provide access to the clearing facility to collect and distribute superannuation payments for employers through SuperChoice Services Pty Limited. ABN 78 109 509 739. Authorised Representative (Number 336522) of PayClear Services Pty Limited (ACN 124 852 320) holder of Australian Financial Services Licence Number 314357.
