

# Spouse contributions

You can help your spouse grow their super by making contributions on their behalf into their Media Super account. You could also receive a tax benefit for doing so.

## Who is a spouse?

A spouse means:

- another person to whom you are legally married, or
- another person, whether of the same or different sex, with whom you are in a relationship that is registered under a law of a State or Territory, or
- a person who, although not legally married to you, lives with you on a genuine domestic basis in a relationship as a couple.

## Eligibility

We can only accept spouse contributions if:

- your spouse is under age 75, and
- your spouse has an account with us – if they need to open an account they can join at [mediasuper.com.au](https://mediasuper.com.au) or call us on **1800 640 886** for a *Product Disclosure Statement*, and
- your spouse has supplied Media Super with their Tax File Number (TFN) – they can call us or log in to their account online if they are unsure or need to supply it.

## Contribution limits

Spouse contributions are after-tax (non-concessional) contributions. This means they count towards the non-concessional contributions cap.

The tax offset isn't available if your spouse exceeds the contributions cap for the financial year or their total super balance is above the general transfer balance cap at the end of the previous financial year. ## Withdrawing contributions

Once contributions are paid into your spouse's account, they cannot be withdrawn unless your spouse meets a condition of release (such as retirement).

## Tax offset

You may be able to claim a tax offset of up to \$540 per year, when both you and your spouse meet certain conditions such as:

- you make a spouse contribution into your spouse's super account
- you don't claim a tax deduction for the contributions
- both you and your spouse are Australian residents when the contribution is made
- at the time of making the contributions you and your spouse were not living separately and apart on a permanent basis
- the sum of your spouse's assessable income (disregarding any first home super saver scheme released amount), including total reportable fringe benefits amounts and reportable employer super (e.g. salary sacrifice) for the financial year, was less than \$40,000.

The tax offset amount reduces when your spouse's income is greater than \$37,000. It phases out when your spouse's income reaches \$40,000.

The tax offset is calculated as 18% of the lesser of either:

- \$3,000 minus the amount your spouse's income exceeds \$37,000
- the sum of your spouse contributions in the income year.

### Example:

You contribute \$3,000 to your spouse's account and your spouse earned \$37,500 this financial year.

$$\$3,000 - \$500 = \$2,500$$

As \$2,500 is less than the \$3,000 spouse contribution the tax offset will be based on \$2,500.

$$\text{Tax offset} = 18\% \times \$2,500 = \$450$$

## Payment options

There are two ways to make a spouse contribution:

### 1. BPAY®

The easiest and most convenient way to make a spouse contribution is using BPAY®.

BPAY® payments can be made by phone or online via your own bank, credit union or building society at any time.

To make a payment using BPAY®, log in or register at [mediasuper.com.au/login](https://mediasuper.com.au/login). Click on 'Add to your super' option, and follow the prompts.

If you can't access your Media Super online account, call us for the BPAY® biller code and your spouse's contribution reference number.
